Inchmery to Lepe

Topographic Beach Profiles 5c00380 – 5c00364



Summary

This policy unit comprises a narrow (~20m wide) shingle beach along the whole 600m of frontage, with muds and gravels a prominent feature to the west. The beach is backed by ~6m high, vegetated cliffs. There are sections of timber groynes, timber and rock revetments and seawall along the majority of the frontage.
